Is Someone Hurting a Child and No One is Listening?

*You can ensure an abused or neglected child
does not slip through the cracks.*



Did you know there are legal tools to protect children that are available to anyone in California?

If you have reported the abuse or neglect to the police, Child Protective Services or your county child welfare agency, **yet you continue to witness or suspect ongoing abuse/neglect of the child**, you can file a Juvenile Court form JV-210 to ask your county child welfare agency to immediately begin court proceedings to bring the child under the protection of the juvenile court.

After you've filed a JV-210, **if the county child welfare agency does not seek court protection of the child, and you disagree with this decision**, you can file a Juvenile Court form JV-215 to have the court review the decision.

Don't let any child slip through the cracks.
